

Spelling and grammatical mistakes.

Abstract:

Sentence beginning "However, the current model". Remove the "However, ".

Section 1:

1st paragraph: change "software portability: a user's scientific application" to "software portability; a user's scientific application"

Just before the bullet points: "The \$OSG_APP model has shown to have" to "The \$OSG_APP model has been shown to have"

2nd bullet point: change "for few VOs" to "for a few VOs"

4th bullet point: change "software are often installed" to "software is often installed"

Section 2:

1st paragraph: change "-the server-" and "-the client-" with "'the server'" and "'the client'".

2nd paragraph: change "This source area at the server" to "This source area on the server".

Section 3.1:

2nd paragraph: change "Users can log interactivley into a user in host" to "Users can login interactivley to a user in host".

Section 3.2:

1st Line: Remove the word "interactively".

1st paragraph: change "invoke itself the internal" to "invoke the internal" and remove the phrase "in this case".

3rd paragraph: change "VO by VO basis" to "a VO by VO basis". I am not sure on the last sentence of this paragraph; "i.e." is used when giving further information and "e.g." is used when giving an example. It is not clear to me which is being done so I will leave it to the authors to decide.

Section 3.3:

1st paragraph: remove "As mentioned, ". Change "Same examples" to "Some examples"

2nd paragraph: A sentence should not begin with "For example". Remove the full stop and replace "For example" with e.g.. Then remove the "etc" at then end, this is not needed as you are listing some examples, not all cases.

Section 4:

1st paragraph: change "CVMFS as content" to "CVMFS as a content"

2nd paragraph: change "reading all content" to "reading content", "from this replica" to "from a replica", and "CVMFS implements" to "CVMFS already implements".

Section 5:

2nd paragraph: change "And VO softwar managers" to "VO softwar managers"

General comments:

Consider replacing the bulletpoints in section 1 with paragraphs. There is a lot of overlap between the bullet points. It is also not a good idea to have bullet points composed from multiple sentences.

In the first paragraph of section 3.3 it is not clear if the publication process is aborted if any of the probes fail or only if any of the critical probes fail.
